










### **C Chord Form**

Note: these are all twelve major chords that use the shape (or form) of the open-position C chord.








# **A Chord Form**

Note: these are all twelve major chords that use the shape (or form) of the open-position A chord.









### **G Chord Form**

Note: these are all twelve major chords that use the shape (or form) of the open-position E chord.








Note: these are all twelve major chords that use the shape (or form) of the open-position D chord.





Note: these are the five forms (or shapes) of the C major chord that are based on CAGED chords.









#### 5 Forms of A chord

Note: these are the five forms (or shapes) of the A major chord that are based on CAGED chords.




# 5 Forms of G chord

Note: these are the five forms (or shapes) of the E major chord that are based on CAGED chords.






### 5 Forms of D chord

Note: these are the five forms (or shapes) of the D major chord that are based on CAGED chords.




## 5 Forms of F chord

Note: these are the five forms (or shapes) of the Bb (flat) major chord that are based on CAGED chords.









#### 5 Forms of B chord

Note: these are the five forms (or shapes) of the B major chord that are based on CAGED chords.




#### 5 Forms of Ab chord
